2. Register for the Night Tracker Ski Pass through Ski Liberty **link on the TRC website*

3. Upload a photo for the Night Tracker Card. **link on the TRC website*

DETAILS Students will bring their ski/snow board gear (helmets required) and all winter snow clothing to school in the morning. Gear will be stored at school – location TBA

Students board the bus immediately after school. Bus departs approximately 2:45 p.m. Buses return to Sparrows Point approximately at 10:30pm. Bus is Gunther Hunt Valley Motor Coach with bathroom, can leave backpacks on bus (locked throughout night)

CHAPERONES Sparrows Point parents will chaperone and will receive a free ski pass for the evening. Those interested in chaperoning should contact Krista at the email listed below. The Ski Club liaison at Sparrows Point is Mr. Imirie.

Note: Ski Club is a VERY INDEPENDENT activity. While we take as many precautions as we can, students ARE NOT DIRECTLY SUPERVISED while on the slopes or in the lodge. Students who are unable to follow the rules regarding departure time, safety and respectful behavior as set forth by the BCPS Code of Conduct and Ski Liberty will be removed from the club without a refund.

- Ski Liberty has extra ski patrol on Friday nights for the clubs
 - Students new to skiing will be required to take a lesson first time. **It is highly recommended that parents of new skiers attend the first ski night if they haven't skied before.**
 - Helmets required
 - A chaperone will remain in the lodge at 'home base' throughout the evening for questions/concerns
 - Chaperones have bright vests easy to see
